
Hello summer, welcome back! A lot has changed in the last few months on the construction site for the North Bala Small Hydro Project. Here's a community update about our activities.

Work completed:

- Excavation of power house
- Excavation of tailrace (where water exits the power plant)

What's next?

Since February, we have been primarily focused on excavation of the powerhouse. The rock excavated has been moved off-site. Some of this material will be re-used to level the terrain for the new park being built next door.

The powerhouse excavation is 21 meters deep. Over the next few months, we will be pouring 5000 cubic meters of concrete to build the powerhouse, enough to fill 2 Olympic sized swimming pools.
